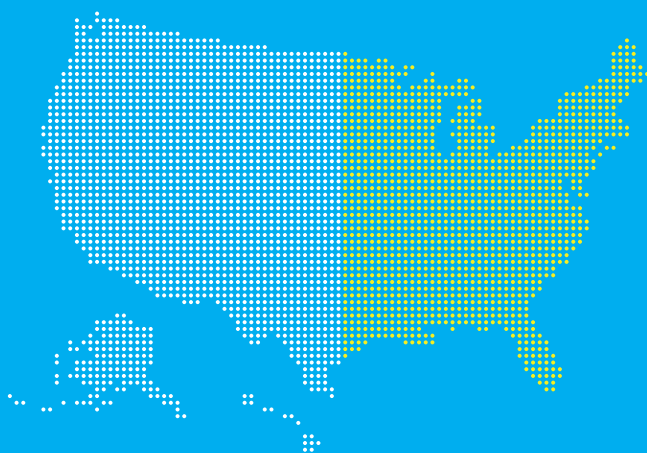

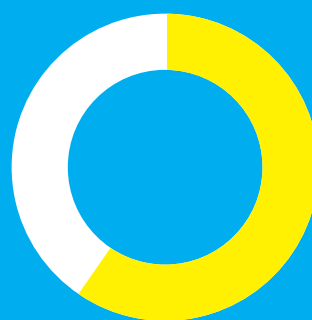
THE LANDSCAPE

91 AMERICANS DIE FROM OPIOID OVERDOSE, INCLUDING PRESCRIPTION DRUGS AND HEROIN
